| ABDUCTION / PERSONAL SAFETY                          | CLIENT             | LOW | <ul> <li>Pupils to be made aware of out of bounds areas on arrival and ground rules to be adhered to.</li> <li>If windows do not have restrictors fitted, pupils must be made aware of safety and security dangers of opening windows.</li> <li>Pupils not to leave rooms once they have been checked in for the evening.</li> <li>Pupils to be instructed not to open room doors to anyone unless they know who is there.</li> <li>After final check in, staff must patrol areas where students are sleeping until pupils are settled.</li> </ul> |

| USE OF HOT EQUIPMENT - BURNS,<br>SCOLDS ETC          | CLIENT             | LOW | Staff must be instructed on the safe use of equipment prior to using hot equipment for cooking or preparing snacks/meals. Training must also detail how to shut off equipment in the event of an emergency.  |
