BEING HIT BY KITE	CLIENT GENERAL PUBLIC	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 'Launcher' to step back 10 paces after launch to watch flight. Pairs or groups to be well spaced in safe defined area. Group to spot each other's kites. Be considerate to other users of public areas. 	
ELECTROCUTION	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NEVER CHOOSE AN AREA THAT HAS POWER LINES 	
MAKING THE KITE	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clear instructions given in use of scissors, when cutting but also moving around the classroom. Clear instructions using saws to cut doweling.
