MINOR INJURIES/ILLNESS	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First aid kit available. • First aider on site whilst activity taking place. • Advise group members of procedures if injury occurs. • Advise group members of procedures if injury occurs. • Ensure medical conditions are known and appropriate medication carried. 	

RUNNING OUT ON TO ROADS	CLIENT	MEDIUM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure all gates are closed. Keep Gates Shut signs attached. • Inform group members that activity is confined to the grounds. • Organise adults to be in the grounds during the activity. 	
TRAFFIC ON DRIVEWAY AT FAIRPLAY HOUSE	CLIENT GENERAL PUBLIC	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gates closed whilst activity in progress. • Warning traffic signs on driveway. • Advise group members of potential danger. 	
CHILD PROTECTION	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Avoid any contact with another person that may be misinterpreted. • Avoid being alone with a young person. • Advise young people to be cautious towards strangers. 	
INSIDE FAIRPLAY HOUSE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • STAIRS • GLASS DOORS • WET FLOORS 	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure all young people know safety issues and rules. • Ensure warning signs are displayed if floors are wet. • Remind young people to walk inside the building.
