<b>INJURY</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eye</li> <li>• Facial</li> <li>• Head</li> <li>• Cuts</li> <li>• Bruises</li> </ul>	<b>INSTRUCTOR</b>  <b>CLIENT</b>	<b>LOW</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Group members wear protective eye goggles.</li> <li>• First aider present.</li> <li>• Care should be taken when putting the line out to avoid low hanging branches and brambles.</li> <li>• Give clear instructions to group on how to protect each other and to move slowly and together.</li> </ul>	
<b>STUDENT MANAGEMENT</b>	<b>CLIENT</b>	<b>LOW</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clear instructions given at start of activity.</li> <li>• Group size – small, adult present whilst on night-line.</li> </ul>	
<b>CHILD PROTECTION</b>	<b>INSTRUCTOR</b>  <b>CLIENT</b>	<b>LOW</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Care to be taken that conduct does not give rise to comment/speculation.</li> </ul>
