HAZARD	AT RISK	DEGREE OF RISK	ACTION TO CONTROL RISK	COMMENTS
ON SITE ACTIVITY EQUIPMENT AND STRUCTURES POND WOODED AREA	CLIENT	MEDIUM	 Emphasise all known in risks in the grounds in briefing and reminder at the start of the session. Ensure group members stay in small groups. When working with young people, advise that adults will be in the grounds of Fairplay House. Position adults at strategic points in the grounds. 	
MINOR INJURY/ILLNESS	CLIENT	LOW	 First aid kit available. First aider present whilst activity taking place. Advise group members of procedures if injury occurs and that they know where the instructor is stationed. Ensure medical conditions are known and appropriate medication carried. 	



RUNNING ON TO ROADS	CLIENT	MEDIUM	 Ensure all gates are closed and that Orienteering' signs are in place. Inform young people that the exercise is within the grounds. Group members will be briefed about map reading. Organise group leaders to be in the grounds whilst activity is in progress.
TRAFFIC ON DRIVEWAY AT FAIRPLAY HOUSE	CLIENT	LOW	 Gates closed whilst activity in progress. Warning signs are placed on the gates. Warning traffic signs on driveway. Advise group members of potential danger.

This risk assessment is reviewed annually or earlier if necessary
