<ul><li>WATER</li><li>Drowning</li><li>Hypothermia</li></ul>	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	<ul> <li>Qualified first aider has first aid kit.</li> <li>Emphasise risks to young people at beginning of session.</li> <li>Buoyancy aid to be worn at the discretion of a senior member of staff.</li> <li>Advise young people how to deal with emergency if it arises.</li> <li>Centre staff to carry a throw line and mobile phones.</li> </ul>	
MINOR INJURY/ILLNESS  Cuts Plants Weil's Disease	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	<ul> <li>First aid carried by centre staff.</li> <li>Have a general regard for hygiene.</li> <li>Ensure any cuts/abrasions are covered to minimise risk of Weil's disease.</li> <li>Ensure medical conditions known and appropriate medication carried.</li> </ul>	



STUDENT MANAGEMENT	CLIENT	LOW	<ul> <li>Ensure work is carried out in small groups.</li> <li>Assess group's trustworthiness and adapt session accordingly.</li> <li>Ensure young people understand behaviour expectations.</li> <li>Ensure all young people have the correct clothing.</li> <li>Visiting staff member to accompany Centre driver.</li> </ul>
CHILD PROTECTION	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	<ul> <li>Care taken that conduct towards a young person cannot be misinterpreted.</li> <li>Avoid being alone with a young person.</li> <li>Advise young people to be cautious towards strangers.</li> <li>Young people work in small groups.</li> </ul>
