HAZARD	AT RISK	DEGREE OF RISK	ACTION TO CONTROL RISK	COMMENTS
TRIPS AND FALLS	CLIENT	LOW	<ul> <li>Brief group as to specific hazards at site chosen.</li> <li>Find an area suitable e.g. park, open land.</li> <li>When at FPH make sure you have a safe area to work in.</li> </ul>	
MAKING ROCKETS	CLIENT	LOW	<ul> <li>When demonstrating the firing of rocket make sure this is done outside the classroom.</li> <li>Clear instructions of use of scissors and how to move around the classroom safely.</li> </ul>	
BEING HIT BY THE ROCKETS	CLIENT GENERAL PUBLIC	LOW	<ul> <li>No person to stand in front of bottle whilst testing the rocket during competition.</li> <li>Construct a clear firing line that all persons stand behind.</li> <li>Group members only collect bottles/rockets when instructed to do so.</li> <li>Make sure the area the rockets are to be fired into cannot be accessed by the general public.</li> </ul>	
ELECTROCUTION	CLIENT	LOW	NEVER CHOOSE AN AREA THAT HAS POWER LINES/CABLES.
