TRIPS AND FALLS	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Brief group as to specific hazards at site chosen. Find an area suitable e.g. park, open land. When at FPH make sure you have a safe area to work in. 	
MAKING ROCKETS	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When demonstrating the firing of rocket make sure this is done outside the classroom. Clear instructions of use of scissors and how to move around the classroom safely. 	
BEING HIT BY THE ROCKETS	CLIENT GENERAL PUBLIC	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No person to stand in front of bottle whilst testing the rocket during competition. Construct a clear firing line that all persons stand behind. Group members only collect bottles/rockets when instructed to do so. Make sure the area the rockets are to be fired into cannot be accessed by the general public. 	
ELECTROCUTION	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NEVER CHOOSE AN AREA THAT HAS POWER LINES/CABLES.
