STUDENT MANAGEMENT	CLIENT	LOW	 Ensure young people understand need for exemplary behaviour. Ensure young people are aware that if behaviour problems arise activity will be abandoned. Young people work in small groups supervised by an adult. Constantly monitor number of people on site. 		
SALT MARSH • Tidal • Entrapment in mud	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	MEDIUM	 Ensure young people are suitable and comfortably dressed. Have regard for tidal conditions and constantly monitor weather. Ensure all young people understand safety implications. Work in small groups with adult supervision. 		
MUD • Entrapment • Tidal	INSTRUCTOR	MEDIUM	 Ensure all young people appreciate risks. Have regard for tidal and weather conditions. Work in small groups with adult supervision. 		



WATERDrowningHypothermia	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	 Ensure no-one goes into the water. Qualified first aider on site. Young people work in small groups with adult supervision.
CHILD PROTECTION	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	 Avoid being alone with a young person. Ensure that no contact with a young person can be misinterpreted. Advise your people to be cautious towards strangers.
MINOR INJURY/ILLNESS	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	 First aid kit carried to field site. Qualified first aider on site. Ensure medical conditions are known and appropriate medication carried.
BIOLOGICAL • Plant poisons	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	 General regard for hygiene. First aider on site. Centre staff aware of known hazard.
EQUIPMENT	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	 Ensure all young people know how to handle equipment. Monitor the use of equipment on site.
