MINOR INJURY	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First aid equipment available in classroom. Qualified first aider on site. 	
STUDENT MANAGEMENT	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure young people have regard for exceptional behaviour. Provision available for withdrawal of young people if behaviour unacceptable. Constantly monitor young people's awareness of how to handle animals. 	
CHILD PROTECTION	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Avoid contact with a young person that may be misinterpreted. Avoid being alone with a young person.
