INJURY - Major - Minor	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	<ul> <li>Instructional Team qualified first aider.</li> <li>Clear briefing on places to hide and hazards to be aware of.</li> <li>2-way radio contact between centre staff.</li> <li>Mobile phone carried by centre staff to call assistance if needed. Ensure medical conditions are known and appropriate medication carried.</li> </ul>	
STUDENT MANAGEMENT	CLIENT	LOW	<ul> <li>Assess group's reliability and co-operation and adapt activity if necessary.</li> <li>Clear concise instructions on what the activity involves.</li> <li>Communicate expectations of behaviour to group.</li> <li>Monitor number of group members at regular intervals.</li> </ul>	



MISSING PERSON	CLIENT	LOW	<ul> <li>Account for all individuals at end of activity.</li> <li>Arrange a signal at beginning of activity.</li> <li>Arrange group return to minibus.</li> <li>Centre staff with knowledge of woodland to conduct search.</li> </ul>
BIOLOGICAL HAZARD	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	<ul> <li>General regard for hygiene.</li> <li>All group members asked to wash hands on return to centre.</li> </ul>
CHILD PROTECTION	INSTRUCTOR	LOW	<ul> <li>Care taken that conduct is not misconstrued.</li> <li>Avoid hiding in woods alone with young people.</li> <li>Young people must never be alone.</li> <li>Young people advised of cautious approach to strangers.</li> <li>No young person must wear a name label.</li> </ul>
