MINOR INJURY/ILLNESS	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First aid carried by centre staff. Qualified first aider present. General regard for hygiene. Ensure any cuts/abrasions are covered to minimise risk of Weil's disease. Mobile phone to be carried by FPH staff 	
STUDENT MANAGEMENT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate clothing 	CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assess group's reliability and adapt session accordingly. Brief group of expectations in behaviour. Count young people on leaving the site and in the minibus. Ensure all young people are suitably and comfortably dressed. 	

CHILD PROTECTION	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Avoid being alone with a young person. • Advise young people to be cautious towards strangers. • Arrange for young people to work in small groups. • Care taken that conduct towards a young person cannot be misinterpreted.
