<b>CHILD PROTECTION</b>	<b>INSTRUCTOR</b>  <b>CLIENT</b>	<b>LOW</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Care taken that conduct is never misconstrued.</li> <li>Avoid being alone with a young person.</li> <li>Advise young people to be cautious towards strangers.</li> <li>Arrange for young people to work in small groups.</li> </ul>
