

FAIRPLAY OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTRE RISK ASSESSMENT **Zip Wire HAZARD AT RISK DEGREE OF ACTION TO CONTROL RISK COMMENTS** RISK FALLING OFF WHILST ON/ AT TOP Emphasise risk during pre-session briefing. **OF TOWER INSTRUCTOR** MEDIUM Ensure correct staff to student ratios. **CLIENT** Clear concise briefing. Client secured on safety once on tower platform. Client correctly connected to the zip trolley. Instructor to secure self when approaching tower dispatch box. Instructor to directly supervise the transfer of the client from safety line to zip lanyards. Check suitable clothing being worn. ON LANDING HITTING THE Persons over 18 stone are not recommended to **GROUND AT A VELOCITY THAT CLIENT** LOW use the Zip Wire. **COULD CAUSE INJURY** Client not put under unreasonable pressure or **PSYCHOLOGICAL INJURY CLIENT MEDIUM** forced to complete an activity against their will. Brake area, Instructor to communicate and PERSON DESCENDING LANDING **INSTRUCTOR MEDIUM** control the timing of jumps with tower.

CLOTHING / HAIR CATCHING IN			Long hair tied back.
EQUIPMENT	CLIENT	LOW	Clothing secure.
			Rescue equipment available to hoist and release.
INJURY FROM JEWELLERY	CLIENT	LOW	 Clients are instructed to remove all loose jewellery before session. Instructor to check that all loose jewellery is removed. Client advised of the risks associated with taking part in the activity with jewellery in place.
BECOMING DETACHED FROM LANYARD AND FALLING TO THE GROUND	CLIENT	LOW	 Clients to be attached to lanyards through sit and chest harness using a belay master during decent.
WEATHER	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	Activity stopped / cancelled if weather presents a significant risk e.g. lightning, high winds
HARNESS COMING UNDONE / FALLING OFF	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	 Instructor to check the correct sizing and fitting of harness Instructor continues to re-check harness throughout the session particularly if removed or adjusted by the client Instructor to tighten mallion with spanner and check bridge is fitted correctly.
EQUIPMENT FAILURE	INSTRUCTOR CLIENT	LOW	 Session leader to carry out visual checks on zip wire before use. All other equipment to be visually checked before and during use.

This risk assessment is reviewed annually or earlier if necessary
